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1. Authenticity rules Belt Flag

1.1. Definition and general requirements

- A competitor must have a belt flag with your number on it that identifies you
- A competitor may have a second belt flag that is decorative symbols and decorations used for this must be based on historical sources. Any clearly modern symbol or decoration is denied.
- No more than two belt flags may be worn by a competitor
 - Examples: Warhammer logo, movies or TV show imagery, modern slogan etc
- Belt flag is an element hung on a belt designed to show your belt number in the list.
- Belt flag must be made of fabric or leather.
- Belt flag must conform with the Textiles and Leather rules document.
- Belt flag consists of a base and a number.
- Base must respect the following requirements:
 - Base shape can be square, rectangular or triangular.
 - Base must have a trim to be worn with a belt.
 - Base must be made of one main color.
 - Some decoration can be added on the edges of the base.
 - Such decoration must not interfere with the readability of the belt flag.
- Number must respect the following requirements:
 - Individual figures must be from 0 to 9.
 - Numbers must be from 01 to 99.
 - Number must be written in Arabic numerals.
 - Number must be 13 cm tall as a minimum.
 - Number can be of any color, contrasting with the base main color.
- All Belt flags must respect the following dimensions:
 - Length: from 26 cm to 36 cm.
 - Width: from 14 cm to 18 cm.
